

$$d = \frac{\overline{x} - \overline{x}}{S}$$




CG Mean = 50 SD = 10



Goal #1: Improve student achievement & close achievement gaps.

Indicators:

- SBAC ELA & math will show 5% cohort growth, and 10% cohort growth for FRPL, minority and ELL students.
- CCSS aligned math curriculum implemented year 2 & English Language Arts (ELA) Curriculum adoption
- All sites will modify schedules to increase core ELA instructional time and dedicated ELD instruction A intervention time. Sites will evaluate and adopt dedicated English Language Development (ELD)
- ELD support at CHS augmented by assigning 1 period of dedicated ELD instruction and bilingual Para.
- Expand implementation and use of Illuminate data and assessment software.
- Students completing A-G requirements will increase by 3%
- Students enrolled in the CHS Environmental Science Academy will comprise >20% of the school population.
- EL's @ Proficient will increase by 5% English Language Learners who are reclassified will increase by 7% 🔀
- AP pass rate (score of 3 or higher) will remain above 70%
- Implementation of CCSS aligned instruction will increase as newly adopted standards are approved by the State Board of Education Science and Social Sciences expected.
- Students will have access to a broad, and increasing course of study. EC51220

- Parent involvement increase at site & district level committees (Site Councils, ELAC's, DLAC)
- School attendance rates will remain above 95%
- Number of students Chronically absent will decrease by 10%
- Middle school and High School dropout rates will decrease by 3% 🔀
- High School Graduation rate will increase by 5% 🔀
- Suspensions decrease by 5% and expulsions will remain below 1% of the student population.
- Student, Staff, & Parent surveys will indicate + and improving safety and atmosphere.
