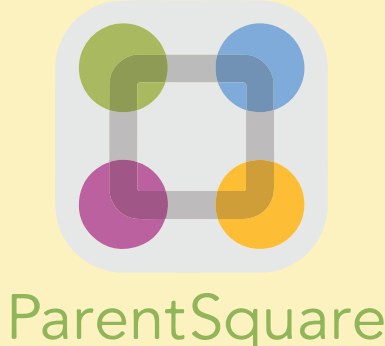
Goal 01
